The proposal is contrary to countryside policy, would be detrimental to the environment and the green space around the village. It would have an adverse impact on Hassocks in terms of increased traffic, and there is insufficient infrastructure in terms of schools, health facilities, water and waste water disposal to meet current demand, so a development of this size could not be supported without considerable infrastructure improvement. There are also concerns that the rights of way over the land would be affected. As the village is developing a Neighbourhood Plan it is premature to be considering developments of this size before local residents have had the chance to comment on the most appropriate areas for sustainable development.
