1. Apologies for Absence. Judith Foot was absent due to illness.

2. Declarations of Interest. None

Public participation. David Tucker of 10 Woodsland Road spoke to express concerns over application DM/15/2985, 8A Woodsland Road, indicating that the proposed windows on the existing plans would have an overbearing effect on his privacy. Mr Tucker believes that the proposed side facing windows in the north facing dormer will provide a view directly into two first floor windows of his property, one being a clear bathroom window. Of particular concern is the stated purpose of the proposed room being a bedsitting room which suggests it will be occupied for greater periods during the day than a bedroom. Mr Tucker also understood that side facing windows in loft conversions need to be frosted to comply with planning regulations. He felt that relocating the windows so that they do not overlook directly into 10 Woodsland Road could address this concern.
