FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS FACT SHEET

How have the proposals come about?

Local residents had raised concerns with traffic and parking issues in the village. Hassocks Parish Council set up a Parking Working Group who consulted with the community and produced a detailed report with recommendations for improvements. These were passed to West Sussex County Council who commissioned CH2M Design Consultants to investigate and produce these feasibility drawings.

If the proposals are supported by residents will they be delivered?

It is the intention of West Sussex County Council to develop further the proposals presented in this public consultation which will be revised subject to resident's feedback, safety audits and the availability of funding.

When are they likely to be delivered?

West Sussex County Council is looking to enter these proposals on to the 2017/18 Integrated Works Programme, but this is subject to the availability of funding and resources.

Where parking restrictions are suggested will they apply to residents of the road as well as casual parkers?

All the proposed parking restrictions will apply to residents of the road as well as casual parkers, in accordance with the Highway Code.

If the proposals were implemented what would be the total cost?

The cost to implement all of the proposals is estimated to be £400,000 and we will work with the community to identify possible avenues of funding.

What is the next stage for these proposals?

Once the public consultation period is complete, all of the feedback received will be reviewed and the proposals will be progressed to detailed design for construction.
